- Fill in all the major and minor scale names.

B# Major	Eleven sharps (F#, C#, G#, D#, A#, E#, B#, F#, C#, G#, D#)
F# Major	Twelve sharps (F#, C#, G#, D#, A#, E#, B#, F#, C#, G#, D#, A#)
